Location Options

My Backyard


Please wait in your car until your lesson time, and I will come out to my driveway and get you. The backyard is set up with a pitching mound and full BOWNET backstop. Turf/tennis shoes required.

- You will need to provide ALL of your own equipment which will include balls.
- I will provide a tee for hitting
- I will provide a home plate

Parkside Elementary School Parking Lot

You will park in the parking lot that has the **flagpole**, however, we will work-out in the other parking lot. What to do:

- You will need to provide **ALL** of your own equipment. This will include a BOWNET if we are hitting or if you need a catcher. Balls, tee if we are hitting and any other equipment needed for our lesson.
- You will need to arrive 10-15 minutes before your lesson to set up your own equipment and warm up.
- Please distance yourself a minimum of 10 parking spaces away from the lesson before you. I will come to you.
